<p>Storage and Handling of Chemicals, Fuels & Oils</p> <p>MINIMUM STANDARD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Transport, storage and handling of fuels and oils must be done in accordance with relevant State statutory requirements. 	<p>Incident Management</p> <p>MINIMUM STANDARD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oil Mallee growers must prepare and maintain an effective Incident Management Plan so respond to incidents that are likely to have national, State or regional significance. This may be in the form of a specific plan that can be activated in the event of any type of incident. 	<p>Neighbour Relations</p> <p>MINIMUM STANDARD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contact must be made with neighbours, and contact details must be provided on the planting site. 	<p>Knowledge Management</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Managers and owners are encouraged to maintain a research capacity or support external research agencies such as CSIRO, Cooperative Research Centres and local research groups as appropriate. The owner or the manager of any Oil Mallee planting is encouraged to join the Oil Mallee Association of Australia.
